3. Electronic communication equipment that permits communication between the coach and wrestler during completion is permitted. True or False?
4. A fall shall not be awarded unless any part of both shoulders or both scapulae of the defensive wrestler is inbounds. True or False?
5. It is stalling when either wrestler repeatedly creates a stalemate situation to prevent an opponent from scoring. True or False?
